

Horizon Europe Action Plan 2022-2026

Horizon Europe, the EU's ninth framework programme for research, is the world's largest research and innovation programme, starting on 1 January 2021 and with a budget of NOK 970 billion.

The importance of international research cooperation in solving major and international challenges is increasing. By participating in Horizon Europe, Norwegian researchers will gain access to knowledge, international networks, research infrastructure and the opportunity to collaborate with the best researchers in their field in Europe and beyond. These are ideas and mindsets that correspond well with the University of Agder's vision in the strategy for 2021-2024: "Co-creation for future knowledge".

For Horizon Europe, the Government has an ambitious target of a return share of 2.8 percent, from 2.49 percent in Horizon 2020. According to Minister of Research and Higher Education Ola Borten Moe, the increased level of ambition requires all Norwegian universities to contribute, including the University of Agder.

The purpose of this action plan is to increase participation in EU-funded research projects for researchers at the University of Agder. To serve this purpose, four priority areas have been defined; Research policy influence, increased participation in EU-funded initiatives and offering researchers a competent support system for applications, contracts and project operations, and efficient processes for applications and project implementation. Under each priority area, sub-goals and activities have been defined to ensure attainment of the objective. The action plan will strengthen the faculties' EU strategies. The University of Agder wishes to participate in the European research community, and in the work to solve major societal challenges. EU-funded research is a priority at the University of Agder, and will in the long term contribute to making the University of Agder a key supplier of high-quality research regionally, nationally and internationally.
